#### What is a Home Equity Line of Credit?

Home Equity Line of Credit (HELOC) is a line of credit that turns your home's value into a pool of cash which you can access as needed.

#### Is it like a second mortgage?

HELOCs resemble a mortgage but work more like a credit card, meaning you can access funds as you need them rather than in one lump sum. Your line of credit is typically calculated based on the value of your home and the remaining balance on your mortgage. They typically have a variable interest rate which means the amount you pay may vary within a given range depending on market conditions. Your interest rate range is usually determined by your credit worthiness.

#### How can I use the funds?

One of the best uses for HELOC funds is to complete major home repairs, renovations or upgrades. You don't need to spend HELOC funds on your home, however. They can be used for just about anything you like! You could use HELOC funds to pay off credit card debt now, and later for college tuition or to buy a car.

#### How is a 1DCU HELOC different?

Most lenders will only lend on 80% of your home's value. We can give you up to 100% of your home's value so you'll have more money to work with!
