PROTECTING YOURSELF **AGAINST FRAUD**

Your privacy is important to us and we take great care to help ensure the protection of our members' data.

Hacking attempts get more sophisticated every day, so it's important to take steps to keep your information and finances secure. Here are some tips you can follow to avoid putting yourself at risk.

1. CREATE A SECURE PASSWORD

You probably already know that using "password12345" is not secure, but there are some risks you might not have thought about when it comes to password security. In addition to choosing a strong password (one that's not easy to guess), it's important to use a unique password for your banking accounts. That way, your information won't be exposed if another site is compromised.

2. BEWARE SUSPICIOUS EMAILS

Phishing is a cybercrime in which scammers send emails and text messages designed to look like they're from a company you know or trust. Phishing attempts often tell a story to trick you into clicking on a link or opening an attachment.

- Avoid falling prey to phishing scams by following safe email practices:
- One Detroit CU staff will never ask for your account information over email. Do not provide personal information to anyone via email.
- Hover over a hyperlink before clicking to view the actual URL where you will be directed. Look out for misspellings or irregularities in the format; it may be fake.
- Beware of emails claiming there's a problem with your account or payment information. To be safe, go to the website where you'd normally login instead of clicking a link in an email. If you see an attachment in an email that you weren't expecting, don't open it! It may contain ransomware or other viruses.

If you got a phishing email, forward it to the Anti-Phishing Working Group at reportphishing@apwg.org. If you got a phishing text message, forward it to SPAM (7726). You may also report the phishing attack to the FTC at ftc.gov/complaint.

3. USE TWO-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION

Two-factor authentication adds an extra layer of security to your login. It makes it much harder for hackers to gain access to your account because they not only need to have your password, they'd need to physically have possession of your phone as well (to enter the passcode texted to your number). donations on your next tax return.
