#### **BEWARE SUSPICIOUS EMAILS**

Phishing is a cybercrime in which scammers send emails and text messages designed to look like they're from a company you know or trust. Phishing attempts often tell a story to trick you into clicking on a link or opening an attachment.

Avoid falling prey to phishing scams by following safe email practices:

- 1. One Detroit CU staff will never ask for your account information over email. Do not provide personal information to anyone via email.
- 2. Hover over a hyperlink before clicking to view the actual URL where you will be directed. Look out for misspellings or irregularities in the format; it may be fake.
- 3. Beware of emails claiming there's a problem with your account or payment information. To be safe, go to the website where you'd normally login instead of clicking a link in an email.
- 4. If you see an attachment in an email that you weren't expecting, don't open it! It may contain ransomware or other viruses.

If you got a phishing email, forward it to the Anti-Phishing Working Group at reportphishing@apwg.org. If you got a phishing text message, forward it to SPAM (7726). You may also report the phishing attack to the FTC at ftc.gov/complaint.
